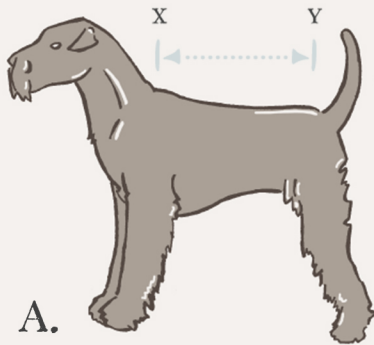

## TO MEASURE YOUR DOG FOR A COAT OR PULLOVER:

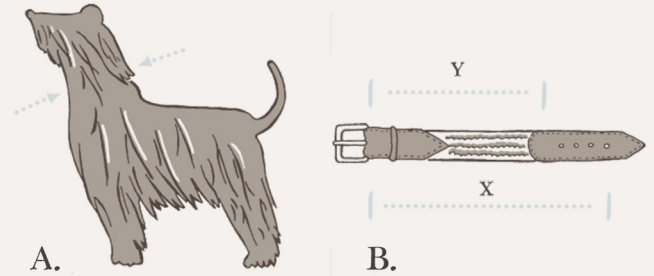


Take 1 tape measure and 1 dog.

Measure from the base of the neck (x) to the base of the tail (y) and record the cm measurement. (See diagram A.)

Choose a coat or pullover that matches the size that you have recorded.

## TO MEASURE YOUR DOG FOR A COLLAR:



Take 1 tape measure and 1 dog.

Measure around the base of the neck, insert a couple of your fingers for comfort and record the cm measurement. (See diagram A.)

Our collars are measured from x to y. We suggest that you choose a collar where the neck size of your dog is between the two measurements. (See diagram B.)
